Gift Restrictions

Due to strict infection control precautions, we can only accept new gifts.

Our hospital is *latex free*. Items such as rubber balloons, koosh balls, rubber stamps, rubber balls, and rubber erasers are not accepted. Mylar balloons and vinyl items are encouraged.
